Biosecurity measures applied in case of an equine disease outbreak


- Notification
- Reporting
- Epidemiological survey
- Movement restrictions
- Disinfection
- Treatment
- Culling

Surveillance for specific equine diseases

- Large proportion of Horses moved in and out of country regularly and be tested for EIA, AHS, Glanders, Dourine and EVA.
- In accordance to the federal law, any suspicion of notifiable diseases should be notified to the responsible authorities.

Temporary and Permanent import of horses?

PRE-EXPORT quarantine	POST-ARRIVAL quarantine
Residence :	Quarantine : 10 days for Permanent importation
For Permanent :	
30 days for EU / 90 days for the rest of the world	
For Temporary:	
40 days	
Quarantine :	Isolation : for Temporary importation
30 days for permanent importation except for EU	(Maximum of 30 days except for Show jumping or The
	World Cup)
