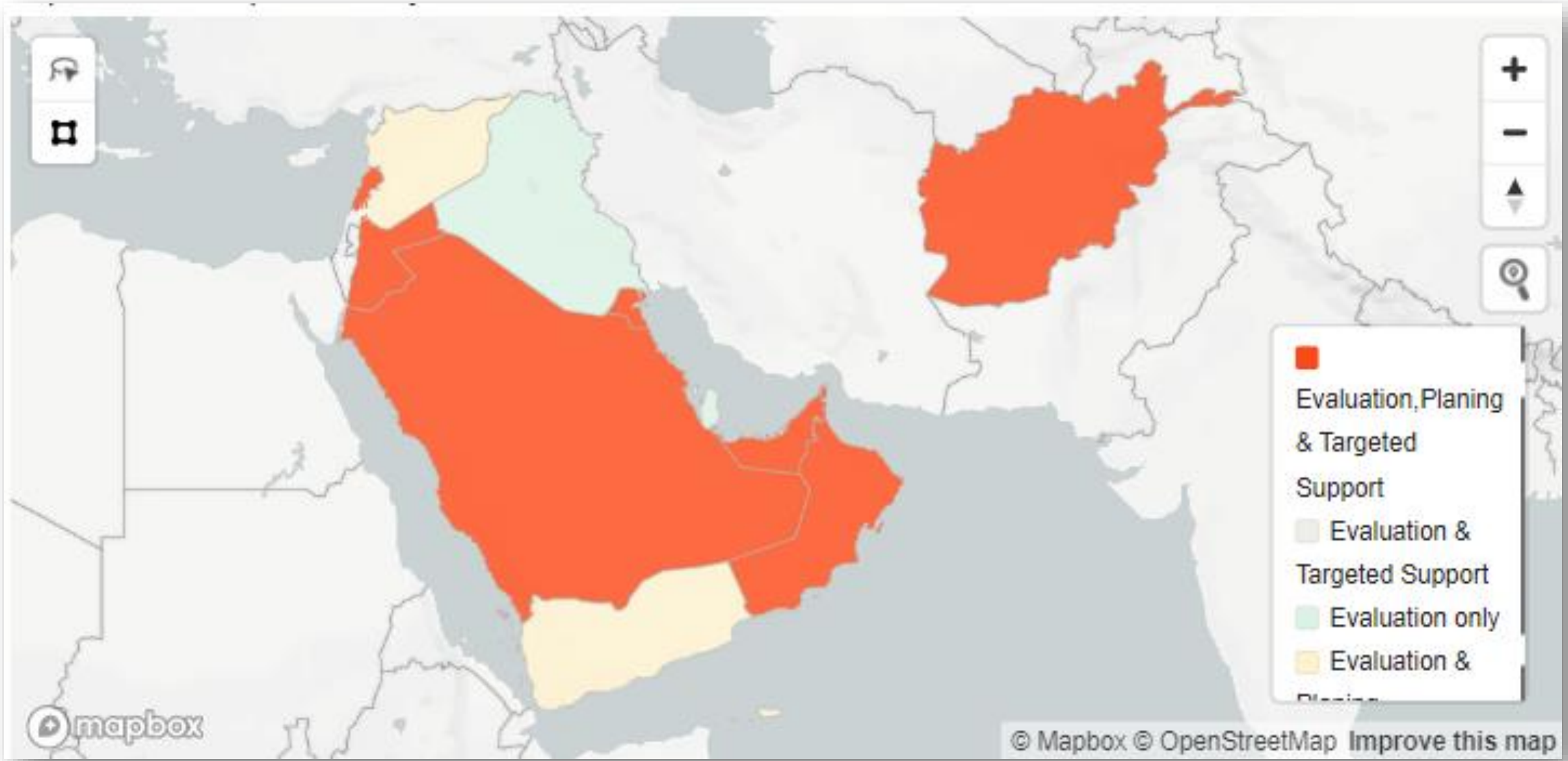

A specific methodology has been developed and the WOA^H has published the WOA^H *Tool for the Evaluation of Performance of Veterinary Services* (WOA^H PVS Tool) as the basis for evaluating performance against the international standards published in the Terrestrial Code.

A similar tool is available for the evaluation of Aquatic Animal Health Services



Reinforcement of the Veterinary Services

- VS – 01 - Countries in the region have progressed in their engagement with the PVS pathway
- VS – 02 – Countries in the region share and report with transparency in their animal health situation
- VS – 03 - Countries in the region have appropriate level of technical capacity for surveillance and control animal diseases and zoonosis.
- VS – 04 - Countries in the region adequately implement and comply with international standards to maintain and improve their animal health situation
- VS – 05 – Countries in the region improve Intersectoral coordination through the one health concept,
- VS – 06 – Countries in the region have appropriate legislation to govern adequately the mandated activities of their Veterinary Services

- VS A1 - Investment programmes supporting the improvement of governance of the VS (including legislation and Veterinary Education)
- VS A2- PVS pathway missions, assessment of the surveillance system and laboratory network.

- VS A4– Compliance with International standards, (WOAH standards, Codex)
- VS A5 – Workshops/Seminars on VS capacity building on information/data collection, notification and communication
- VS A6 – Activities and investment in reinforcing solid coordination for safer trade; The BESST initiative.

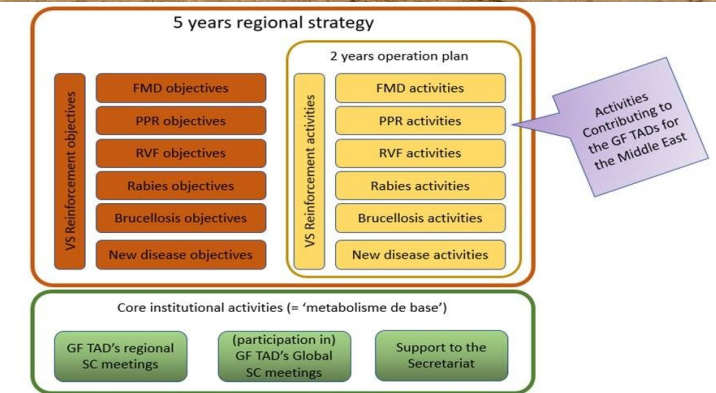
