



Suspended status: Indonesia, China and Mongolia















Objective of the Campaign

- Improved transboundary trade of livestock and animal products.




Involvement of SEACFMD Governance Bodies






✤ a cluster approach to animal disease control;



Private Sector Consultative Committee (PSCC)



- to strengthen coordination and engagement of Veterinary Services (VS) and Private Sector.
- ✓ to better understand the challenges, Private Sector, industry, VS facing in FMD prevention and control, and opportunities going forward.
- ✓ -to explore the creation of a subregional network of representative traders acknowledging their important role in FMD transmission in the subregion and, thus, their potential role in FMD control.

Case studies: SEACFMD Members

 Public Private Partnership (PPP) on FMD vaccination in Thailand presented by Thai Holstein Friesian Association. 'KHOK KHO Model' partnership with Milk Collecting Centres (MCC),and Department of Livestock Development (DLD).

- Vietnam highlighted the investment in private companies like Dairy Food Joint Stock Company, a dairy farm that fully covers FMD vaccination for its operation and provides training for private veterinarians to support vaccination campaign.
- Partnership of General Authority for Veterinary Services (GAVS) with the **Private Veterinary Units (PVUs)** to implement **FMD** vaccination, and its reporting in Mongolia.
