Proceedings of the Workshop

During the 76th OIE General Session in May 2008, the International Committee of the OIE reiterated the importance of the Focal Points for animal diseases notification and requested delegates to nominate additional Focal Points for: wildlife, veterinary products, animal production food safety, animal welfare and aquatic animals.

OIE Focal Points, nominated by OIE delegates and acting under their supervision, are an important mechanism for countries to satisfy to their OIE obligations and to strengthen communication and collaboration between member countries and the OIE.

In the global framework of OIE Focal Points' training, the OIE Regional Representation for the Middle East (RR-ME) organized special training for OIE Focal Points on Animal Production Food Safety (APFS) from the 2nd to the 4th of February, in Kuwait City.

This training was hosted by the Public Authority for Agriculture and Fisheries (PAAF) of the State of Kuwait and the sessions were held in the conference room of the PAAF building.

Back to back with this training, a specific practical session on BSE was also organized in collaboration with the European Commission and France, within the facilities of the Central Veterinary Laboratory (CVL) of Kuwait.

OIE Focal Points on APFS from the following 11 countries attended this workshop: Bahrain, Cyprus, Jordan, KSA, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Qatar, Syria, UAE and Yemen.

The PAAF also invited some observers involved in food safety in Kuwait, and a total of 69 persons attended this workshop.

The Inauguration Ceremony

The workshop was inaugurated by Eng Jassem Habib Al Badr, Chairman and Director General of the PAAF. He welcomed all the participants of the workshop and said that it was a pleasure for Kuwait to host such a meeting. He also expressed his gratitude to the OIE for the strong support and assistance provided to the VS of Kuwait, particularly through the OIE PVS process (PVS Assessment, Gap Analysis and Legislation) and to the CVL, with specific assistance and a twinning project. He also thanked the OIE Regional Representation for the Middle East for its

Dr Ghazi Yehia, OIE Regional Representative for the Middle East, thanked the Kuwait authority for the extraordinary hospitality and cooperation in the organisation of this workshop. He reminded the participants that training is an important part of capacity building and improvement of competencies of Veterinary Services, which is one of the main mandates of the OIE. He also mentioned that the Regional Representation will still be involved in this domain, in compliance with its mandate adopted democratically by the OIE Regional Commission for the Middle East, and that, in 2010, 4 trainings of OIE Focal Points will be organized. Eng. Nabeela Ali Al Khaleel, Deputy Director General of Animal Resources (PAAF), welcomed all the participants and thanked the OIE Regional Representation for proposing that the State of Kuwait should hold this training. She explained that food safety is a very important domain where VS should be involved, particularly in the Middle East where this competency is usually shared with other Ministries and/or Agencies. She also expressed the interest of the GCC countries in getting more information on BSE and notably on BSE diagnostics and she thanked the OIE Regional Representation for its initiative to organize, in collaboration with the EU and

work to improve animal health in the region.



of Focal Points on APFS in Kuwait, the agenda will include training of Focal Points on wildlife in Tanzania in March, animal welfare in Lebanon in August and aquatic animals in UAE in September.

Training on Animal Production Food Safety

The training was hosted by Dr Stuart Slorach, Chairman of the OIE Working Group on Animal Production Food Safety, Dr Ghazi Yehia, OIE Regional Representative for the Middle East, Dr Wim Pelgrim, from the OIE International Trade Department in Paris, and Dr Pierre Primot, from the OIE Regional Representation of Beirut.

After providing general information on the OIE (role, objectives, mandates, structure (at global and regional levels) and management), they described the role of the OIE Delegate in each country, his rights and obligations, and explained the work of each of the OIE Focal Points, assisting the Delegate in their relevant domain of competencies. A specific focus was made on the Terms of Reference of the OIE Focal Point on APFS.

Some important concept, such as the Good Governance of Veterinary Services, the concept of Global Public Good, to qualify the work of Veterinary Services worldwide, were underlined with a focus on OIE actions in such areas through the OIE PVS Tool: assessment of Veterinary Services through a standardized and recognized procedure in order to identify areas for improvement and additional expertise to enhance the quality of Veterinary Services, in compliance with the OIE Standards, such as the Gap Analysis, the PVS Follow-Up and the Legislation expertise.

They also underlined the role and work of the Working Group on Animal Production Food Safety, and detailed the relevant OIE Standards on APFS: ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection of animals, identification and traceability, prudent use of antimicrobials, salmonellosis in poultry, animal feeding and sanitary certification.

Specific information was also given on the current relationship between the OIE and the Codex Alimentarius Commission and their future collaborative activities in the domain of food safety.



During the session, Dr Hani Al-Mazaidi, from the Kuwait Institute for Scientific Research (KISR) explained the roles of other governmental services in food safety in Kuwait and his vision of consumers' expectation in terms of food safety.

Dr Dueaj Mohammad Al-Husain, from the United Poultry Company, described the existing collaboration in Kuwait between the Veterinary Services and the private sector.

National OIE Focal Points on APFS were also invited to present the situation in their respective countries, using a framework proposed by the OIE RR:

1. Competencies of VS in terms of Food Safety
2. Actions of VS in terms of Food Safety
3. Main issues in your country
4. How to improve the situation?

The Focal Points of Bahrain, Cyprus, Jordan, KSA, Kuwait, Lebanon, Oman, Syria, and Yemen each made a presentation accordingly.

Several points could be highlighted from the different country reports:

- In most of the Middle Eastern countries, the competent Authority in terms of food safety is multiple, in the hands of several other ministries or national agencies. This situation leads to an overlap of competencies, reinforced often by bad collaboration and/or competition between all these authorities;
- In most of the countries the competencies of Veterinary Services are limited to the farm level and, considering that the Middle East supply on food products rests on large imports, the main strategy to control the sanitary quality of food products is to establish strong control and sampling at the border;
- Most of the countries underlined the poor collaboration and communication with all the relevant stakeholders acting in the food chain. The same goes also for the consumers: very few educational and awareness programmes are dedicated to food safety;
- The legal arsenal is also very weak or unsuited in most of the countries to take into account all the steps to guarantee safe products from the "farm to the fork";
- None of the countries have a relevant system to identify and trace products;
- Most of the countries mentioned poor laboratory capabilities in terms of food safety.

Facilitated by simultaneous English – Arabic interpretation, discussions were very active and fruitful during these two days.

Participants shared the same idea to build a network of OIE Focal Points on APFS at the regional, or even global, level, to discuss in particular issues they are facing.

Some participants also raised the problem of the Halal certification which may differ from country to country. Concerning this particular issue, representatives of the OIE explained that the OIE standards are only dedicated to sanitary aspects.

Practical session on BSE

Following the request of several Members, notably countries from the GCC, the OIE Regional Representation proposed to organize a specific practical session on BSE after the training of the OIE Focal Points on APFS. This session was organized with the support of the European Commission (EC) and France, who provided experts.

Dr Paulo Luciano (EC), Martial Plantady (EC), Jocelyn Merot (France) and Viviane Moqay (France) presented during this one day session the SPS market access issues with a focus on BSE, the legal framework of measures to prevent, control and eradicate BSE in the European Union and the example of France, and the principles to diagnose BSE.

A demonstration of how to collect samples at the slaughterhouse was also made in the relevant facility of the CVL, providing also cattle heads and participants were invited to do it themselves.

Conclusions

This workshop for OIE Focal Points on APFS is part of a large programme of the OIE, providing information and training to each nominated Focal Point in order to improve collaboration and communication of each country with the OIE.

Considering the lack of competencies of Veterinary Services in terms of food safety and the fact that a large part of the food supply consists of imports, this workshop was a first step to enhance the knowledge of Focal Points on APFS, on OIE standards and on their role, according to their relevant Terms of Reference.

In a world where more and more customers want to know exactly what they are eating and where there is a need for good and safe food prepared in a hygienic manner, the competencies of Veterinary Services should be recognized and expressed, particularly in the Middle East where the responsibilities of the Competent Authority are shared between several other Ministries or Agencies, often resulting in overlapping of competencies.

The proposal to build a network of regional OIE Focal Points on APFS would be also a good start to improve collaboration and exchange of information between all regional countries, playing a large part in improving knowledge of and respect for standards.
