Recommendations:

Countries in the region to:

- a. Revise and update of national legislation to ensure that the legal framework supports the implementation of NSP on PPR;
- b. Strengthen VS capacity in surveillance and control of PPR and other small ruminant's infectious diseases.
- c. Strengthen national laboratory/ies diagnostic capacity based on WOAAH standards and guidelines through sustainable laboratory support activities.
- d. Increase stakeholder awareness and engagement through the development of customized communication and extension materials;

Countries to achieve stage 1 (assessment) and stage 2 (control) before 2023 (in alignment with the 4 components of the PPR GEP

- a. Providing concrete advisory support for the implementation of the countries NSP, mainly through the organisation of workshops/training on risk analysis and epidemiological assessment, and through the provision of high-quality vaccines procured through the WOAHP vaccine bank;
- b. Supporting the development of quality management laboratories for the diagnosis of PPR and other small ruminants diseases
- c. Developing capacity building programs to support the preparation of ME countries' applications for the endorsement of official control programmes for PPR and for official recognition of PPR free status by the WOAHP;
- d. Follow-up progress made by member countries in the stepwise approach PMAT, and coordinate activities with the GES, mainly through the PPR secretariat and the FAO/OIE offices and the GF-TADs RSC.
