


<u>Structure/organisation</u> of the Veterinary Services in [Jordan]

Strengths

- Regulatory frameworks improved
- Animal identification system
- Regular notification to WOAH about animal health situation
- Ambitious project for disease free zone in Maan
- Good laboratories (central)
- Some quarantine facilities

Weaknesses

- Lack of real strategy
- No authoroty of CVO on the whole veterinary domain
- Understaffing (official vets/ Paravets)
- Lack of emergency funding
- Weakness in passive and active surveillance
- No delegtion for any official activities to the private
- No program for continous education
- Weak consultation between different parties

- Control animal and zoonotic diseases (prioirity list diseases)
- PPP
- Enhance quarantine and laboratories
- Increase consultation between veterinary parties and health
- animal welfare
